

**Abstract of the Article**  
**"Introduction of New Forms of Special Legal Regimes**  
**of Economic Activities in Ukraine"**  
**by O. Yegorova**

The modern crisis phenomena in world and domestic economy became a call for Ukraine concerning the search of adequate economic toolkit and effective ways of its application for a fast exit out of the crisis and overcoming of its negative consequences. Special legal regimes of economic activities (SLREA) can be one of such tools, that predetermines the necessity of reconsideration of principles of application of this economic toolkit in Ukraine, induces to its use for overcoming of financial and economic crisis and providing with directions on investment-and-innovation development of national economy, increase of its competitiveness on the world market. Therefore, the problem of introduction of new forms of SLREA in modern Ukraine at present is especially burning.

Regulatory legal acts, including bills, concerning introduction and functioning of forms of SLREA that are new to Ukraine, that is scientific parks, investment parks, industrial parks, innopolices, territories of perspective development are analyzed. Thus, the attention is focused on the problems and disagreements that they have, concerning with the international obligations taken by Ukraine and operating national legislation, and also on insufficient definition of the role of SLREA, as the economic toolkit of realization of the strategy of the development of regions and the country as a whole.

The sound proposals concerning the improvement of regulatory-legal base in this sphere are made for providing the systems and hierarchies of statutory acts. In particular, it is offered to make legal the general bases of creation and functioning of operating and new forms of SLREA in the frame of law.
